

Studland Parish Council Motion for 2020 AGM

“The parish and town councils throughout Dorset strongly object to the loss of local democracy outlined in the proposals contained in the White paper on Planning. Parish and Town Councils wish to retain the ability to participate in planning matters so as to reflect the views of the residents that they represent.

The Dorset Association of Parish and Town Councils (DAPTC) , as the representative body for local councils, demand that there should be no loss of democratic contributions to the planning process

In support of this demand;

- i) The DAPTC urge Dorset Council to support the position of the Local Government Association on the proposed loss of democracy.
- ii) The DAPTC urge NALC to work with others to lobby government to withdraw those proposals that remove local democratic contributions to the planning process.
- iii) The DAPTC lobby all eight Dorset MPs over the proposed loss of democracy.”
