



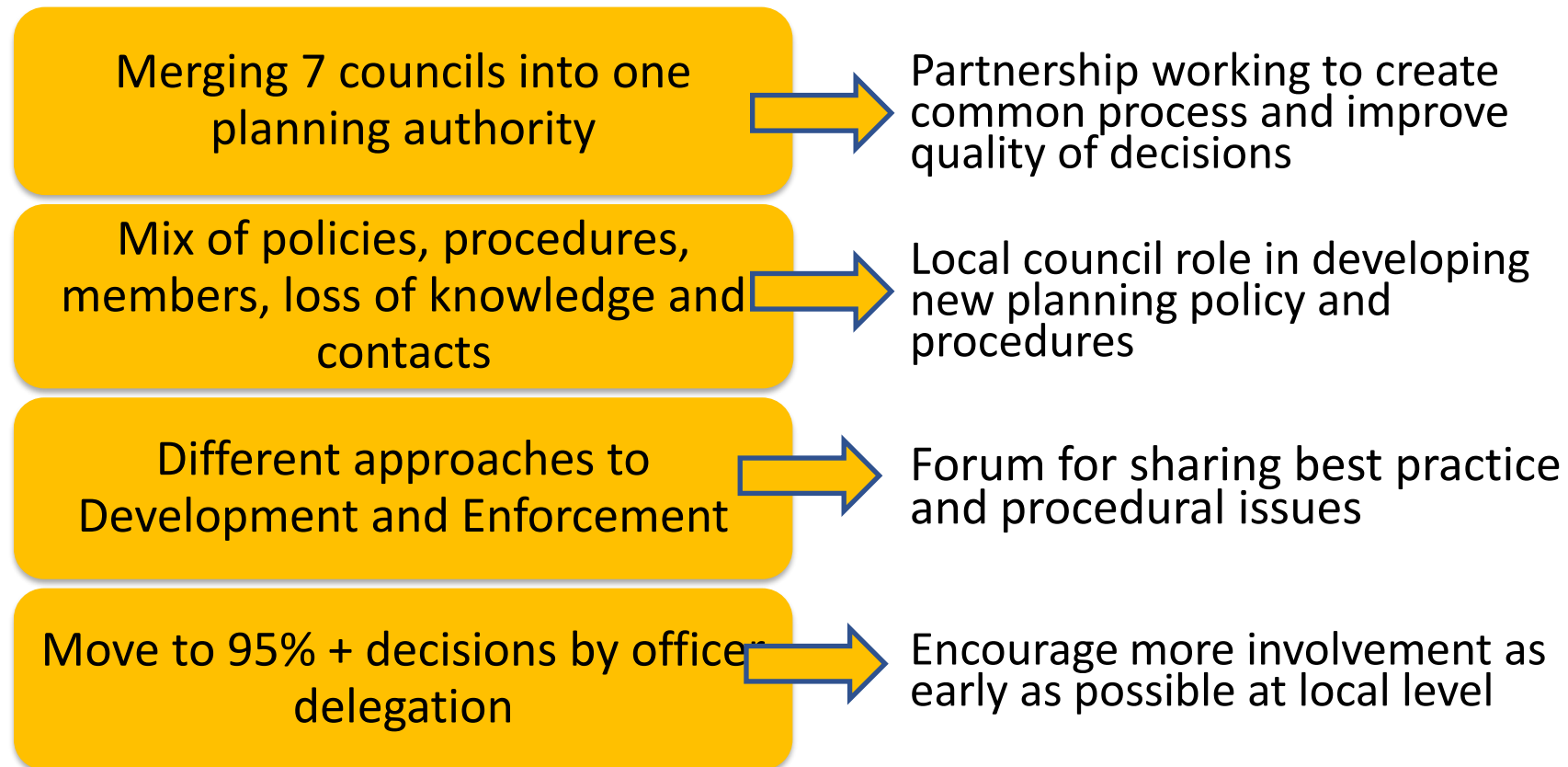

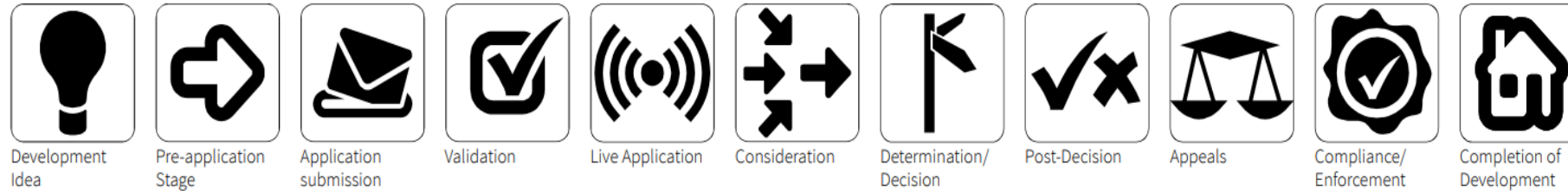

INTRODUCTION



CIL

- Planning Partnership Paper approved by Cabinet
 - All local councils receive CIL payments – even if zero rated
 - Creation of CIL community fund with remaining CIL funds
 - Open to bids from local councils and communities against an annual theme
 - Planning Partnership representatives have a role in the final grant allocation (£1.15m in 2022/3)
